Psalm 25:2 NIV

No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those who are treacherous without cause. Psalm 25:3 NIV

Those who look to him for help will be radiant with joy; no shadow of shame will darken their faces. Psalm 34:5 NLT

In you, Lord, I have taken refuge; let me never be put to shame. Psalm 71:1 NIV

Help me abandon my shameful ways; for your regulations are good. Psalm 119:39 NLT

May I wholeheartedly follow your decrees, that I may not be put to shame.
Psalm 119:80 NIV

"Fear not; you will no longer live in shame. Don't be afraid; there is no more disgrace for you. You will no longer remember the shame of your youth and the sorrows of widowhood." Isaiah 54:4 NLT
